KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Norwood National Bank of Greenville a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of United States of America and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

D. L. Norris,

All that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, on the south side of E. M. Bee Avenue, having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at a point on the south side of E. M. Bee Ave. 121 ft. 1/2 inch from the eastern side of S. Main St. at corner of lot this day conveyed by the Grantor to Mills and Manning and running thence along the center of a 12 inch brick wall, being the eastern line of the lots this day conveyed to Mills and Manning and to Parish and Fowler, S. 20 49 ft. 5 1/2 inches to line of lot conveyed by Sue Harris Carle to D. L. Norris by deed recorded in Vol. 53 page 53, thence with line of said last mentioned lot S. 70-01 ft. 21 ft. 8 1/2 inches to corner of said lot on the western face of a brick wall; thence still with line of said lot, conveyed by Carle to Norris; along the western face of said last mentioned brick wall, N 20 E. 55 ft. 8 1/2 inches to E.
