KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, C.B. Holliday, of the County of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Six thousand (\$6000) DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

T.M. Hunt, (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

T.M. Hunt, and his heirs and assigns, forever:- All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
 situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, about three
 (3) miles west of the City of Greenville, on both sides of the new road, running from a point near
 the Monaghan Mills to a point near Cunningham's store, containing twenty seven and one-hundredth
 (27.01) acres, more or less, according to a plat thereof made by W.A. Adams, bearing date September
 19, 1911, having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:- Beginning at
 a stone, and running thence along line of the Huff land, S. 32.35 E. nine and seventy-four -
 hundredths (9.74) chains to an iron pin; thence N. 55.55 E. twenty-seven and seventy-seven hund-
 redths (27.77) chains to an iron pin; thence N. 32.35 W. nine and seventy-four hundredths (9.74)
 chains along line of J.B. Wynne's land to an iron pin; thence along line of R.E. Allen, S. 55.55
 E. twenty-seven and seventy-seven hundredths (27.77) chains to the beginning corner; and being
 the same lot of land conveyed to me by John M. Palm, as Executor of the last will and testament
 of Tallulah J. Feaster, deceased, of Greenville County, by deed bearing date January 4th, 1912,
 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume 16, page 31.

 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
