 in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J. Herman Campbell, of the County and State aforesaid (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. Herman Campbell, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate,
 lying and being in Grove Township, in the County and State aforesaid, lying on both sides of new
 road leading from Charles Shop on Augusta Road to Piedmont, bounded by lands of John Henry Charles
 and others, beginning on a stone on an old road 3X near Flat Rock (colored) Church, thence N.
 3-1/2 W. 17.00 to iron stake 3XNM; thence S. 65 W, 17.80 to a stone 3XNM; thence S. 40-3/4 E. 17.26
 to a stake, corner of said Colored Church Lot; thence N. 58-1/2 E. 7.10 to the beginning corner,
 being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J.H. Charles, by his deed bearing date November
