in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Two hundred fifty DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

D.E. Connor (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

D.E. Connor all that certain piece, lot and parcel of land in Chick Springs Township, State and
 County aforesaid aforesaid, beginning at iron pin, corner of I.P. Few and C.L. King, running
 West 397 feet to iron pin on Buncombe Road, thence, North with said Buncombe Road 275 feet to
 the right of way of the U. S. & A. Ry. Co., thence along said right of way, East 397 feet to
 iron pin, thence South 132 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1-1/2 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
 wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
