Emily Trammell, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the county and State aforesaid in those townships near the town of Piedmont between the public road leading from Piedmont to Greenville and the C. & G. R.R. and containing one half acre more or less and bounded by lot formerly owned by S. Hutchinsan, J. H. Charles & T. W. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Lena Trammell and Emily Trammell of Greenville County in consideration of the sum of Twenty-two hundred and Fifty (\$2250.00) DOLLARS to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by U.A. Trammell

(the receipt whereof is here- by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

U.A. Trammell, all that lot or parcel of land, situate on the west side of the road leading from the city of Greenville to the town of Piedmont, in the county and State aforesaid, near the said town, known in the division of the real estate of Rankin Beaman deceased, as lot No. 9, containing four and sixteenths (4 3/8) acres more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on said road and running thence down the same 6.50 to a stone, thence N. 73 and 1/2 W. 5.50 to a stone, thence S. 82 and 1/2 W. 1.50 to a stake, thence S. 66 E. 10.00 to the beginning; see plat of W. F. Lee, surveyor, in the record of said case, judgment case No. 21 being the same lot or parcel of land conveyed by D. P. Danner, Master for Greenville county by deed to B. F. Trammell, U.A. Trammell and M. F. Trammell, dated the 2nd day of January, 1893 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Courthouse for Greenville county in Book XV, page 100.
