of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid  
and in Santt Township about six miles from Greenville S.C., and  
is a portion of the land deeded to me by Richard H. Jacobs by  
deed dated Oct. 1886 & Recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County
