KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Rebecca J. Watson of the City and County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. C. Harris, of said City and County and State (the receipt whereof is here-

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said G. C. Harris, and his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina in the City and County of Greenville, did being known and designated as lot no. 4 according to a plat thereof, made by Wm. W. Hudson, W. S. bearing date January 29th, 1907, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at corner of W. R. Payne's lot and running N. 18 W. 55 feet thence W. 12 1/2 feet, more or less, to corner of lot no. 5 belonging to Rebecca J. Watson, to iron pin, thence 55 feet more or less to corner of W. R. Payne's lot, thence 128 ft. more or less to beginning corner and containing 7040 square feet more or less. This being part of the lot conveyed to Rebecca J. Watson by H. C. 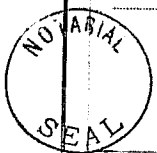
