is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W.L. Vaughn, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on Cane Creek, tributary waters of Enoree River, and is portion of the J.T. Vaughn estate known as lot No. 4, and has the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at i.p. corner in Taylors Road, corner of lot No. 3, and running thence N. 89-30 E. 5.78 i.p. corner in Greer Road; thence with said road 9.93 to i.p. corner and corner of lot No. 3; thence on with said road 19.80 to iron pin n.m. in said road; thence N. 20 W. 23.75 to stake in Cane Creek; thence up Cane Creek in old run of Creek, 23-80 to stake corner and corner of lot No. 1, opposite mouth of branch; thence up said branch 20.05 to maple corner; thence S. 27 W. 8.18 to i.p. in Taylors road; thence with said road 5.79 to beginning corner, and contains 68 acres, more or less, and is bounded by lots No. 1, 2, 3, & 5.
