KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I James Young of Greenville  
County

in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of  
Five and no/100 <sup>and other good and valuable considerations</sup> DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Amanda Young (my wife) of the  
County and State aforesaid,

(the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Amanda Young, and her heirs and assigns, the following de-  
scribed real estate, to wit:  
First: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Green-  
ville, in Chick Spring Township, on Mountain Creek and Reser-  
voir Roads, and having the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning at a rock on Reservoir Road, and  
running thence N. 85 1/4 W. 14.25 chains to sawwood 3x, thence S.  
37 1/2 N. 15.16 chains to stone 3x and thence S. 4 1/4 E. 12.78 to persim-  
mon, thence S. 20 E. 1.95 to center of Mountain Creek Road;  
thence with said road N. 33 1/4 E. 2.90 to bend in road, thence  
N. 73 1/2 E. 6.50 to intersection of Reservoir Road <sup>thence a government Reservoir Road</sup> N. 24 E. 10.32 to  
bend; thence N. 26 E. 5.13 to bend; thence N. 5 1/4 E. 5.00 to the  
beginning corner, containing thirty-three (33) acres more or  
less.

Second: Also all that other certain piece, parcel or tract of  
land situate, lying and being in the same State, County and  
Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to  
wit:  
Beginning at a stake on a branch, on the line  
of King and Grant, and running thence due S. 196 feet to a  
stump 3x0; thence N. 29-33 E. (224 feet to a stake on Road,  
thence across said road N. 28-45 W. 88 feet to a stake on  
branch; thence up the branch to the beginning corner,  
containing eight-tenths (8/10) acre, more or less, these  
being the whole two parcels of land conveyed to me by  
A. W. Green, by deed dated Sept. 11th, 1914, and recorded in  
the R. T. C. Office for said County and State in Volume  
# 26 of deeds, at page 453, to which reference is hereby  
made.
