all of the right, title and interest of Grace May Watson, Herman Manning Watson, Alvin Earle Watson and Ida Lou Watson, in and to, all that certain parcel or tract of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, on the branch waters of Rocky Creek, branch waters of Enoree River, containing sixty acres, more or less, and with such bounds, marks, etc., as follows: Beginning on a stone 3x; thence N. 13-3/4 N. 12.25 to a P.O. 3x0; thence N. 58-1/2 N. 20.00 to a P.O. 3x0; thence S. 30 N. 6.64 to a chestnut 3x0; thence S. 8-1/2 N. 14.85 to a black Jack 3x0; thence S. 10-3/4 E. 12.43 to a hickory 3x0; thence S. 22-1/4 N. 3.00 to a stake 3x0; thence S. 59-1/2 E. 3.45 to a stone 3x0; thence N. 57 E. 26.00 to the beginning.

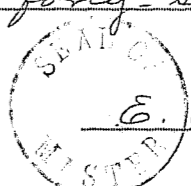
