of \$150.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

real estate to-wit: all those two certain
lots of land situate, lying and being
in the City of Greenville, County and State
aforesaid, as follows:
One of said lots being the same lot
which was conveyed to R. B. Milbay by W. R.
Shackleton by deed which is recorded in
the R. M. O. Office for the County and State
aforesaid in Deed Book, Vol 46, Page 503;
the other lot being the same lot which
was conveyed to R. B. Milbay by J. A. Prier
by deed which is recorded in the R. M. O.
Office for the County and State aforesaid
in Deed Book Vol 26, Page 320. Each of
said lots were owned by R. B. Milbay
at the time of his death. Said lots of
land are situate on Judson Alley and
Knave Street, in Ward Six of Greenville
City.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
