HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Jamerson, all the right, title and interest of Frank Stringer, deceased, the same being an undivided one-half interest therein, in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County above named, in the town of Greer, with the following metes and bounds: Beginning on Albert Street at the corner of lot No. 18, and running thence S. 9-30 E. 60 feet to the corner of lot No. 20; thence with the line of lot No. 20, S. 80-30 W. 106.6 feet to corner; thence N. 2-06 W. 53.8 feet to the line of lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence N. 80-30 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, it being a part of the Marchant place.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Mrs. H.F. Jamerson, her heirs and assigns forever.

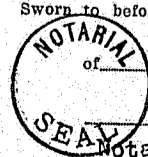
