Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said S. B. Huff
his heirs and assigns forever, the following de-
scribed real estate, to-wit: All that certain store house
and lot fronting on Rudolph Street in the City of
Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and described
as follows: Beginning at a corner pin on Rudolph
Street corner, alley leading from Rudolph Street
at right angle back to the Myrtle alley stable lot
thence with Rudolph Street 22 feet 11 1/2 inches
to center of wall of adjoining store; thence with a line
at right angle with the said front line 100 feet to
corner pin on back alley; thence with the alley 22
feet 11 1/2 inches to a corner pin corner of alley
leading out to Rudolph Street; thence with said
alley 100 feet to the beginning corner.
The same being a part of lot conveyed by J. L.
Southern Sheriff to S. B. Huff by deed dated
November 1, 1875 A. M. C. 634.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;

heirs and assigns forever.
