"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate on the South side of Harview Street in the Town of Fountain Inn, and being known and designated as lot of the subdivision of the Fountain Inn First Baptist Church property, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Maggie Thomason (now Bobb) by the Deacons of the Fountain Inn Baptist Church by deed bearing date the 18th day of November 1908, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. Joel Greenville County in deed book 383 at page 615"

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.
