Sudduth and others, having the following metes and bounds, viz; Beginning where the National Highway crosses the said Greenville, Spartanburg and Anderson Railway and running thence along the center line of the right of way of said Railway as the line to where it crosses the old Rutherford Road; thence in a Southerly direction with the said old Rutherford Road to an Iron Pin, C.C.
