NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Julia May Swift Poe

In consideration of the sum of one dollar and a house and lot in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.W. Morgan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W.W. Morgan his heirs and assigns all that piece parcel and tract of land, situate lying and being in Bates Township, County and State aforesaid, on the White Horse Road, containing thirty acres, more or less as surveyed by W.A. Heister December twenty ninth, 1916 and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a flint stone, the north west corner the same point being a corner of the lands of Kern Duck and J.T. McKinney and running thence S22°-15' E. 3.36 chains to a stone on my West line; thence S89°-30' E. 48.30 chains to an iron pin in the White Horse Road; thence north along said Road said Road N0°-30' E. 6.35 chains to iron pin on White Horse Road; thence S83°-45' W 50.80 chains to point of beginning; the same being a part of the tract of land conveyed to me by H. J. Poe for May 19th 1914 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 28, page 560.
