(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A. Katy, and his heirs and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and City and County of Greenville, in Ward # 2 of the City of Greenville on Stone Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of East Stone Avenue, 164.4 feet from the Northeast corner of said Avenue and North Main Street and running thence N. 17° E. 157 feet to a stake; thence N. 19° E. 51 feet to a stake; thence S. 73° E. 53 feet to a stake; thence S. 17° W. 208 feet to a stake on the north side of East Stone Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 73° W. 54 feet and 4 inches to the beginning corner, this being a portion of the parcel land conveyed to me by W. H. Ballentine, by his deed dated May 26th, 1911 and recorded in the C. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Volume # 17 of Deeds, at page 326, to which reference is hereby made.

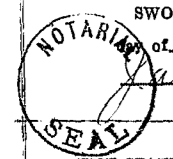

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. D. McHugh, his heirs and assigns, my right title and undivided interest, if any, and to wit that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in District Township, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning on a stone corner and running thence S. 88 1/2 E. 14.15 chs. to a stone; thence N. 2 E. 22.00 chs. to a stone; thence N. 88 1/2 E. 5.00 chs. to a stone; thence 1 1/2 E. 24.25 chs. to a stone; thence N. 89 W. 11.65 chs. to a stone on Rail-road right-of-way; thence along the said right-of-way to the beginning corner, and containing ninety-eight (98) acres, more or less - less 2 1/2 (6) acres sold and conveyed thereon to C.
