(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. H. Cary, all of our interest in the following described piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville as follows:
 Beginning at a stake on Green Ave. one hundred and fifty feet from the Right of Way of the C & G. R. R. and running thence north eighty feet to a stake, thence West thirty feet to a stake on Green Ave. thence East thirty feet to a stake on Green Ave. the beginning point being part of lot no. 1 as shown on plat recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plot Book C, page six.

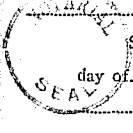
