DEED TO C. C. White

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Thos A Putman of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS, to C. C. White in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. C. White, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece of land or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Austin Township, near Mauldin known as Tract #4 of the J. W. Jenkins Estate, and having the following sites and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3 1/2 on the Greenville & Laurens Road, at corner of Putman and Tract No. 3, of lands of said J. W. Jenkins, deceased, and running thence N. 16 3/4 W. 2.56 to an angle on said road; thence N. 6 1/4 W. 11.08 to a stone 3 1/2 on said road; thence E. 72 1/4 W. 40.40 to a stone 3 1/2; thence N. 73 E. 43.40 to a stone 3 1/2; thence N. 1/2 W. 64 to a post oak stump; thence N. 57 3/4 E. 11.63 to the beginning corner, containing 41 acres more or less—Less 39 75/100 acres sold and conveyed therefrom to Anthony White, see Deed Book "G. G. Q." at page 1446, thus leaving 50 acres more or less which is intended to be conveyed by this deed. This being the same tract of land conveyed to me, the said Thos A. Putman by J. W. Gray, Master for Greenville County, S. C. by deed dated Jan'y, 10th, 1908 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book "N. N. N." at page 159, to which reference is hereby made.

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TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said C. C. White, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. C. White, and his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
