NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John H. Williams of the County of Greenville, and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable ^{considerations} in the State aforesaid, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

R. M. Tammahill Company (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. M. Tammahill Co. All that piece, parcel or lot of land between the North Saluda and South Saluda Rivers, and to the centre of each River containing twenty-five acres more or less and hath such marked bounds etc. as follows viz:—Beginning on 2 maps on North Saluda River thence N. 87 W. 18.00 to a stone on South River, thence down the meanders of said River 13.50 to a stone, thence S 87 E. 20.00 to a stone on North Saluda River, thence up the meanders of said river 13.00 to the beginning corner. Bounded by estate of Jerry Whitmire, Mr. Hunt, W. A. Hudson, and Saluda Power Company. Said land is a part of the tract sold by Hamilton Bentue and Avery Patton to Mrs Laura Morwood and by her to W. A. Hudson, and deeded by W. A. Hudson to me, April 9th. 1910.
