in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Daink Jackson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Daink Jackson, All that piece, Parcel, or lot of land, situate lying in the State and County aforesaid, which springs Township, Beginning at an iron pin on Frohawk Street and running North along said Street fifty five feet to an iron pin; thence West 122 feet to an iron pin; thence South 55 feet to an iron pin; thence East 122 feet, to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Charles Henderson, M. D. Fowler, Lee Johnson and others; said lot being a part of land, deeded to me by M. D. Littlefield, and being near the Town of Creek, South Carolina

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Daink Jackson

heirs and assigns, forever, AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Daink Jackson his heirs and assigns, against my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
