 in consideration of the sum of Forty Five hundred (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. M. Bouchillon

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. M. Bouchillon
 All that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, lying on the north side of East Earle Street, and known as lot no. 26 of section 5 on Stone Land Company, made by J. E. Surine, Engineer, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book A page 527, and is described as follows:
 Beginning at an iron pin 360 feet from the East side of Summitt Street and running thence S. 71.20 E. with said Earle Street 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 18.30 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence N. 71.20 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence S. 18.30 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner on said Earle Street. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by T. F. Hunt by deed dated July 1st, 1919, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 43, page 527.
