THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, County of Greenville

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Cleveland King, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS, to and in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. E. Cason

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. E. Cason, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, fronting fifty (50) feet on Ninth Street and running back one hundred fifty (150) feet and being known and designated as Lot # 23 in Block "A" in plat of property recorded in Plat Book "A", page 427, R. M. C. Records for Greenville County and being one of the lots conveyed to me by C. W. Dill by deed dated September 28, 1914, and recorded in Vol. 38, page 43, R. M. C. Records for Greenville County, reference to which plat and deed is had for a more complete description of said lot.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said L. E. Cason his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said L. E. Cason his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

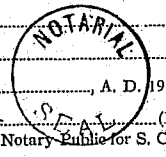

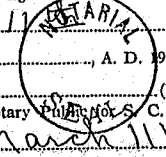
