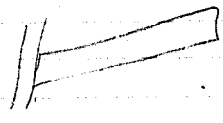


J. C. Milford DEED TO George Brownlee  
 THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
 County of Greenville  
 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. C. Milford, of the County of Greenville,  
 in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars and other good and valuable considerations in the State aforesaid,  
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George Brownlee,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said George Brownlee his heirs and assigns;  
 All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being on Burns Alley in Ward six of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:—

Beginning, at an iron pin on Burns Alley and running thence N. 78-30 E. one hundred and thirty-seven and 5/10 (137.5) feet to an iron pin corner of George Brownlee; thence with his line N. 13-11 W. eighty (80) feet to an iron pin on line of Mrs Carl's lot; thence with her line S. 74-30 W. one hundred and four and 5/10 (104.5) feet to an iron pin on Burns Alley; thence with said alley S. 14 W. seventy-nine and 5/10 (79.5) feet to the beginning corner.



TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said George Brownlee his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said George Brownlee his heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
