NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, of the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and above agreement DOLLARS, to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.T. Henderson and T.F. Hunt

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W.T. Henderson and T.F. Hunt, All that certain lot of land situate in Ward One of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of West Earle Street, one hundred and eight and three-fourths (108-3/4) feet westward from the southwest corner of Earle and Wilton Streets, and running thence along the south side of Earle Street N. 84-1/2 W. fifty-four (54) feet 4-1/2 inches to a stake on Earle Street; thence S. 5-1/2 W. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to a stake; thence S. 84-1/2 E. fifty-four (54) feet, 4-1/2 inches to a stake on the southwest corner of lot No. 7; thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 5-1/2 E. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to us by Eugene F. Bates by deed dated September 29th, 1916, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 41, page 158.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W.T. Henderson and T.F. Hunt, their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND We do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.T. Henderson and T.F. Hunt, their

heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
