County State of South Carolina in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Ten (10) Dollars and other valuable considerations,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Louise Bondar Richardson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Louise Bondar Richardson all that certain parcel or lot of land
situate in Ward two (2) of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina, lying bet the Northeast corner of
Carolina Avenue and Pettigrew Street, and having according
to a plat thereof made by Will D. News, Engineer, the
following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an
iron pin at the northeast corner of said Carolina Avenue and
Pettigrew Street and running thence with Pettigrew Street in
a westerly direction eighty-one (81) feet and five (5) inches to
iron pin in line of Monteith's lot; thence along line of last
mentioned lot N. 15 W. ninety-eight (98) feet to an iron pin
on edge of a ten foot alley; thence along said alley S. 76.4 W. 5
ft. seventy-six (76) feet eight (8) inches to an iron pin on
east side of said Carolina Avenue; thence with the East
side of said Carolina Avenue S. 15 E. one hundred twenty
