 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, D.D. Davenport of the town of Greer in the  
 County of Greenville in the State aforesaid,  
 in consideration of the sum of Land in exchange DOLLARS,  
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.P. Moore, of Spartanburg County  
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
 J.P. Moore, two triangular shaped pieces of land lying north of a line having the course of  
 S. 73-1/2 W. and a length of 412 chs. having its beginning on west side of Mill Street 3.59 chs.  
 from center of Main line of Southern Railway in center of Street crossing and 2.42 chs. from  
 D.D. Davenport corner at the intersection of Cannon Street with Mill Street and contains  
 about one-fifth of an acre, more or less and more fully described by plat made by J.B.  
 Williamston, October 3, 1883, situate, lying and being in the town of Greers in the County  
 and State aforesaid, south of Southern Railway and north of Canon Street, adjoining the  
 Randall lot.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
