 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E. E. Stone of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Addie Tucker Watson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Addie Tucker Watson, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and in the County and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville on the west side of Townes Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point, on the west side of said Townes Street 150 feet south of the south-west corner of Croft and Townes Streets and running thence N. 83-13 W. one hundred thirty one (131) feet to a stake on west line of lot No. 45; thence with west line of said lot S. 1-41 W. fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence with southern line of said lot S. 83.13 E. one hundred thirty one (131) feet to Townes Street; thence with Townes Street N. 1-41 E. fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner and being the southern portion of lot No. 45 of Section "E" of a plat of the Stone Land Company, said plat recorded in Plat Book "A" page 337-345.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Addie Tucker Watson, her heirs and assigns, forever,
