In consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. H. Moore

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. H. Moore all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid near the town of Greer, on the South side of the old National Highway, adjoining lands of J. J. Wood and others, and being the same lot conveyed to me by J. J. Wood by deed bearing date of Jan. 24th, 1913 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Vol. 34, at page 60, and bearing the following general and bounds, courses and distances: Beginning at an iron pin in the intersection of said old National Highway and an unnamed street formerly the Beaufort Canal and runs thence with the said highway 70 feet to an iron pin, J. J. Wood's corner; thence with J. J. Wood's line 60 feet to J. J.
