 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G.B. Bishop

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said G.B. Bishop, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid about two miles West of the Court House of the City of Greenville, and being a portion of the property known as City View:
 Beginning at a stake on Henderson Street, 200 feet from Summit St., joint corners of lots Nos. 54 and 55, and running thence N. 0-30 E. with line of Henderson St., 100 ft., to a stake, joint corners of lots No. 56 and 57; thence in an easterly direction with joint lines of lots Nos. 56 and 57, 150 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 56, 57, 1 and 2 thence in a southerly direction with joint lines of lots Nos. 2, 3, 55, and 56, 100 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 3, 4, 54 and 55; thence in a westerly direction with joint lines of lots Nos. 54 and 55, 150 feet to the beginning corner, being designated as lots Nos. 55 and 56, Block A., according to a plat made by W.A.
