(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said H. P. McKeel

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Mountain View Avenue, corner of lots 14 and 15 and measuring thence N 73 3/4 E. 289 feet to a stake on a ten foot alley, thence along said alley S 72 1/2 E. 100 feet to a stake on said alley, thence N 73 3/4 W. 273 feet to a stake on Mountain View Avenue, corner of lots 15 and 16, thence N 80-15 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner. This lot being known as lot no. 15 of section "A" on plat of Beut Circle, as made by J. B. Rogers in August, 1911 and recorded in R. M. C. 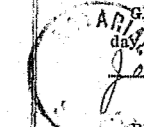
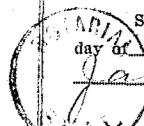

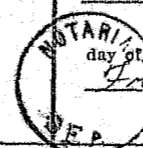
