Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and  
easement to pass over that tract of land, situated in  
said County and State bounded by lands of B. M. Woods on the  
North, Alfred on the East, A. Bradley on the South; C. C. Jeter  
on the West and to construct and maintain in, upon, and  
through said premises in a proper manner, with poles, towers,  
wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for  
the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and  
telephone service, together with the right at all times, to enter  
upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines  
and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together  
with the right to cut, remove and keep clear of said lines,  
all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way  
endanger the proper operation of the same.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement  
of all claims for said easement, any damages to crops  
planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if  
such can not be arrived at mutually, the damage shall be  
determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the  
holder of this grant, and the two so appointed, to select a  
third. The decision of any two of the three arbitrators shall be  
final.

Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors  
and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and  
upon that tract of land situated in said County and State  
bounded by lands of H. F. Roberts on the North, Fred Krews on the  
East, H. H. Roberts on the South & H. F. Roberts on the West  
and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said  
premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and  
other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose  
of transmitting power by electricity and telephone service, together  
with the right at all times, to enter upon said premises for  
the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary  
repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to  
cut away and keep clear of said lines, all trees and other  
obstructions that may in any way, endanger the proper  
operation of the same.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement  
of all claims for said easement, any damages to crops  
planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon and if
