KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Frank Eppel, of Greenville
County

in the State aforesaid,

and other good and valuable Considerations
to M. E. Kautzel
at and before the sealing of these presents by M. E. Kautzel

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M. E. Kautzel, and her heirs and assigns, All those two certain pieces parcels or lots of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County and Township of Greenville, near American Spinning Company, and having such metes and bounds as appear in a deed from J. M. Dickson to me, the said J. Frank Eppel, said lots being known and designated as Lots # 237 and 238 of the Bailey & Guidley Land. Said lots having a frontage of 66 feet each on Bailey Street and running back in parallel lines 150 feet, according to a plat of said land, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for said County and State in plat book A, at pages 278 and 279, these being the same two lots of land conveyed to me by J. M. Dickson, by deed dated 15th day of Dec. 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for said County and State in Volume # 43 of Deeds, at page 41, to which reference is hereby made.

This deed is executed subject, however, to the mortgage given by G. M. Bates to Miss M. McNeill for the sum of \$700.00 bearing date 22nd day of Aug. 1914 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for said County and State in Vol. # 29, at page 1253 of real estate mortgages, which said mortgage the grantee herein assumed and will pay as part of the consideration of this deed.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said M. E. Kautzel and her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said M. E. Kautzel and her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, except the mortgage hereinabove mentioned.
