KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Shuler Reid

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Eighty one and 9/100 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by P. L. Dill

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
P. L. Dill, all my one third interest in all that certain parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on waters of Beaver Dam Creek and a part of the same land conveyed to J. S. Reid (deceased) by Alexander P. Parker by Deed bearing date of Sept 8th. 1890 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. of Greenville County in Vol. 47 page 302, and more fully described as follows: beginning at a stone on the South east side of the old State road (former) a persimmon and runs thence S. 72 1/4 W. 19.00 chs. to a stone on P. L. Dill line; thence N. 59 E. 7.20 chs. to an iron pin on the east bank of a branch; thence down the said branch N. 48 E. 3.62 chs. to an iron pin in center of said branch; thence continuing down the said branch as the line in a North Eastern Course 6.95 chs. to a stake across Beaver Dam Creek opposite the mouth of the aforesaid branch on the Mr Jim Langley's line; thence with the said line S. 51 3/4 E. 40.70 chs. to a W. O. (gone) in the fill of the New State road; thence S. 11 1/2 W. 3.20 chs. to the beginning corner and containing six and one seventh (6 1/7) acres more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said P. L. Dill, his
