L. H. Littlefield; All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone on the Mostella Road and runs thence S 88 1/4 E. 31.06 chains to a stone; thence N. 5 E. 15.10 chains to a stone; thence N 86 1/2 W. 31.92 chains to a stone on the said Mostella Road; thence with said road 15.94 chs. to beginning corner, containing Thirty Six (36) acres, more or less.

Also all that other piece, parcel or tract of land situate as aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a corner in Mostella road and runs thence with said road 14.35 chains to a stone; thence S 89 1/4 E. 7.00 chs to a stone; thence N. 61 1/4 E. 8.20 chains to a pin; thence N. 88 W. 7.00 chains to beginning corner, and containing Seven (7) acres more or less.
