in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and twenty-five and 00/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. McWhorter of Greenville S.C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. C. McWhorter in his own and assigned heirs

"All that certain piece, parcel & lot of land situate on the west side of Main Street between Lexington Street and Llanero Street in ward 5 of the city of Greenville and known as lot # 2 of a part of the property of the United States, said lot having been made by William Jones, dated March 31, 1913, said lot having the following limits and corners:  
Beginning at an iron pin in west line of Main Street sixty (60) feet from the corner of property owned by Elias McKee, this beginning point being the southeast corner of lot # 1 of said tract with view of Main Street S. 21-44 W. Sixty (60) feet to an iron pipe stake point being the northeast corner of lot # 3 of said tract; thence along N. line of said mentioned lot N. 76-21 W. one hundred and seventy six feet (176.3) and three inches to an iron pin in line of lot now or formerly owned by Frank Quinn; thence in the line of last mentioned lot N. 18-34 E. fifty nine feet (59.6) and six inches to an iron pin, this point being the southeast corner of lot # 1 of said tract; thence with the line of last mentioned lot S. 76-21 E. one hundred and seventy nine feet (179.6) and six inches to an iron pin, beginning point."
