in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations Dollars,
to us In hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by H. W. Batsou

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H. W. Batsou, his

heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, to wit; all that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County aforesaid, and being known and designated as tract number one, according to a subdivision and plat of the land of J. W. Batsou, deceased, made by W. C. Hester, surveyor, on February 26th, 1918, and containing four-tenths and ⁴⁸/₁₀₀ acres, and having the following meter and bounds and courses and distances; Beginning at a stone near plantation road, and running thence N. 40 E. 2.00 to P. O. down; thence N. 1. E. 28.50 to stone x.v.m.; thence N. 89 1/4 W. 23.96 to stone x.v.m.; thence S. 28 E. 33.00 to chestnut (down) per stone; thence S. 74 3/4 E. 5.69 to stone at the beginning corner.
