to me In hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by W. C. Smith, of the County of Greenville

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. C. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Buck Springs Township, between the waters of the Enoree River and the Green-Pelham road, beginning at a stone west of Minnie Dillard's dwelling, corner of her land, and running N. 2 1/2 W. 19.14 chs. to a stone; thence S. 88 1/4 E. 13.84 chs. to an iron pin in the center of the new Green-Pelham road, thence up the said road S. 4 1/4 E. 5.56 chs. to a pin in the center of the same road (52 links N 77 1/4 E. from a post oak 3x, and original corner, west bank of old Green-Pelham road) thence S 77 1/4 W. 14.20 chs. to beginning corner. Containing ten 1/2 (10 1/2) acres, more or less, according to survey and plat made by W. A. Christopher Feb. 28-1917.

This tract of land is a part of the tract conveyed to H. L. Dillard by the Executors of the Manning Dillard Estate and is bounded on the north by lands of H. L. Dillard, on the east by H. L. Dillard, on the south by Minnie Dillard, and on the west by W. C. Smith.
