in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of 56 DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by N. E. Lockhart of Greenville, County South Carolina

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said N. E. Lockhart,

A certain tract or parcel of land known as the Abner Waldrop home place, deeded to him by Pres. A. B. Bowers, on a branch of Jamesons Creek, beginning on a red oak stump 76.42 E. 24.50 chains South 6 N. 17.50 chains to a white oak 37, thence 76.42 3/4 N. 24.50 chains to a pine on Mt. Church road; near the corner of the Bennett Cotton patch, thence north with the road East 9 chains to a black oak in fork of the road near Abners home, thence conditionally to the Rock corner 37 in place of the Chestnut 49 E. 9.62 chains to beginning corner, containing nineteen acres the same more or less adjoining land of N. E. Lockhart James M. McClure, R. F. Belile, and Oak Grove Church lot.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
