(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said M. E. Lockhart,

A certain tract or parcel of land known as
the Abney Waldrop home place, deeded to
him by Rev. A. D. Bowers, on a branch of
Jamesons Creek, beginning on a red oak
stump N. 42 E. 24.50 chains South 6 N. 17.50
chains to a white oak 37, thence N. 42 3/4 N.
24.50 chains to a pine on Mt. Church road,
near the corner of the Bennett Cotton patch,
thence north with the road East 9 chains
to a black oak in fork of the road near
Abney home, thence conditionally to the
Rock corner 37 in place of the Chestnut
49 E. 9.62 chains to the beginning corner, contain-
ing nineteen acres of the same more
or less adjoining land of M. E. Lockhart
James M. McClure, R. F. Belier, and Oak Grove
