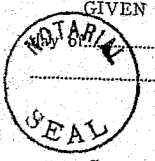

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty three Hundred and fifty (\$2,350.00) to me paid by William A. Parker, Bessie Parker and George M. Parker

Just outside the city limits, known and designated as lot no. 17 of Block F. On a plat of Park place recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat Book A. at page 119, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the west side of first avenue one hundred feet from the intersection of said avenue and 2nd street and running thence west one hundred and fifty feet to a stake in a ten foot alley; thence with said alley south fifty feet to a stake, the corner of lots nos. 17 & 15; thence with line of lot no. 15 one hundred and fifty feet to a stake in first avenue; thence with said avenue north fifty feet to the beginning corner.
