Casle and C. M. Blythe all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the north side of South Main Street, in the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as lot 24, on plat of the property of Thomas M. Walker Company, subdivided and recorded in the R. M.
