In the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on the north side of Birnie Street corner of Norris Brothers property thence along line of Norris property N. 30-0 E. 25.9 feet to an iron pipe on right of way of C. & N.
