

William Simes DEED TO Hauteuse Abercrombie

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, William Simes, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Six thousand, five hundred and eighty and 1/100 (\$6,580) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Hauteuse Abercrombie of Greenville County

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Hauteuse Abercrombie, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and located in Dupplin Township containing ninety-four and 1/2 (94 1/2) acres, more or less and having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a stone at or near the branch, and running thence S. 32 1/2 N. 16. 69 to a pine; thence S. 71 E. 12. 40 to a stone; thence N. 34 1/2 E. 6. 11 to a stone on the Dupplin Bridge road thence along said road 2. 57 to a stone; thence crossing said road and running thence S. 36 1/2 E. 6. 65 to a stump thence N. 73 3/4 E. 14. 74 to a stone; thence S. 12 E. 5. 13 to a stone; thence N. 6 1/2 E. 15. 00 to a stone; thence N. 25 E. 15. 77 to a stone on or near branch; thence up the branch to the beginning corner, being Tracts Nos 1, 2, 5, and the small home track of a plat of the William Simes land made by J. P. Willis, Surveyor, not yet recorded but to be recorded and referred to as a part of the tract of land willed to William Simes by Elizabeth Simes, containing 205 acres, more or less.
