Twelve Hundred no/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Larry Blakely

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Larry Blakely, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying, and being in the State of South Carolina, and the County and City of Greenville; in the 4th Ward of said City, fronting the main line of C. & W. O. Railroad, and having the following meter and bounds, according to a plat made by R. E. Dalton Engr. July 1916, to wit:

Beginning at iron pipe corner lot 1-a, and running thence N. 24-57 E. 137.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 73-28 W. 65 feet to iron pipe on the East line; thence S. 18-42 W. 135.5 feet to iron pipe; thence S. 71-55 E. 50 feet to beginning corner, and known as lot 3-a on the plat above named, which plat is recorded in Plat Book 6, at page 86, and being same lot conveyed to us by J. A. M. Bullough, by deed and recorded in R. M. O. Office for said County and State, in Vol. 55 page 31.
