(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

John W. Wilson,

All that certain tract of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about three miles from Greenville Court House, on the Bent Bridge Road; Beginning at an iron driven in the center of the Bent Bridge Road, in line of J. P. Owings land and corner to land of Ross Arnold and runs thence along said Arnold's land S. 22-59 W. 1518.6 feet to an iron corner of said Arnold's land; thence leaving said Arnold's land and running along land of J. O. F. Home N. 53-13 E. 160.76 feet to an iron; thence S. 87-32 E. 600.9 feet to an iron driven in an old stump; thence S. 82-27 E. 255 feet to an iron corner to land retained by the said N. H. Harris; thence along Harris line N. 13-07 E. 1434.5 feet to an iron in the center of above mentioned road and in line of said Owings; thence along said line S. 87-32 W. 203 feet to an iron at the bend of the road; thence still along same S. 86-13 W. 514.48 feet to the point of beginning, containing 25.61 acres, more or less, and excepting therefrom one-half of an acre now used as a graveyard.
