(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

C. F. West, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, near Traceland Cemetery, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit, -
 Beginning at an iron pin at the southeast corner of white and Railroad streets, and running thence along the east side of white street S. 15-0 E. 37.0 feet to stake; thence N. 74-56 E. 68.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 15-0 W. 35.4 feet more or less, to point in Railroad street; thence S. 89-0 W. 75 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner this being the western portion of a certain lot of land conveyed to me by J.
