Morgan, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Glassy Mountain Township, and containing 179-62/100 acres, more or less; and having such metes and bounds as are shown on plat made by Fitzpatrick Terry Co. October 1919, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in plat Book E, at page 174; this being the same land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, Master for Greenville County by deed dated 21st day of June, 1913, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Volume # 14 of Deeds, at page 138, to which reference is hereby craved.

The intention of this deed is to convey all the land which I now own in Glassy Mountain Township, and being known as the W. H. Weston Place.
