near the city of Greenville, South Carolina, in a
subdivision of land known as South Cherokee Park
and designated on a plat of said subdivision as part
of lot No. 24, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book A, at page
130 and having the following metes and bounds
to wit:
