HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

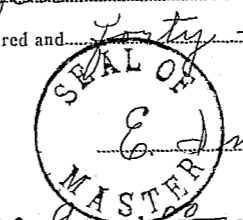
C. H. Garies and Annie P. Garies, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate to wit:  
All that lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on Buncombe Street, Randy's corner; thence N. 57 E. 180 feet; thence N. 29 1/2 W. 67 1/2 feet; thence S. 57 W. 186 feet to Buncombe Street; thence with Buncombe Street S. 33 1/4 E. 70 feet to beginning corner, and being the same lot described in the deed from E. Inman, Master, to John Fosselle and Willie Fosselle, dated June 10th, 1918, and recorded in P. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Vol. 52, page 239"
